#### **Community and School**

Cristo Rey St. Martin College Prep High School (CRSM) is a Catholic, co-educational college preparatory school located in Waukegan, Illinois. CRSM offers a rigorous college preparatory curriculum and a 10 month school year. Opened in 2004, CRSM is a member of the national Cristo Rey Network of schools, which provides quality, Catholic, college preparatory education to students of limited means and educational options. All students at Cristo Rey Network Schools participate in a work-study program through which they finance the majority of the cost of their education, gain real world job experience, grow in self-confidence, and realize the relevance of their education. This work-study program is referred to as the Corporate Work Study Program. Cristo Rey St. Martin strives to develop the full potential of its students in an atmosphere of mutual respect for the religious and cultural heritage of each individual. The school prepares bright students from urban communities for college acceptance and graduation, a successful career, and the ability to make positive changes in their communities.

#### Faculty

The faculty consists of 25 full-time teachers, two full-time school counselors, two full-time college counselors, one alumni director, and two full-time resource teachers. Fifty percent of the full-time teachers hold Master's degrees. Ninety-one percent of the teachers are certified. The student to faculty ratio is 17:1.

#### **Corporate Work Study Program**

The bedrock of Cristo Rey St. Martin is the Corporate Work Study Program. Students are placed into entry-level positions within companies and organizations throughout Lake County, IL, Northern Cook County, IL and Kenosha, WI. The fees students earn from these jobs cover over 60% of the cost of their education. Students develop practical job skills and experience in a variety of industries including law, health care, banking, finance, engineering, education, pharmaceutical and non-profit services. Each student works five full work days per month, without missing any scheduled classes. By the time they graduate from CRSM, each student will have spent an amount of time at their jobs exceeding that of an entire academic year. Each student has a direct supervisor and receives two comprehensive performance reviews each year. Several alumni have reflected that their work experiences at CRSM have been very beneficial to their successes at colleges/universities and beyond.

## **Graduation Requirements**

A total of 28 credits are required for graduation. Yearly courses earn 1 credit and semester courses earn 0.5 credits.

### **Counseling Department**

Counseling at CRSM has three departments: Academic/Social/Emotional Counseling and College Counseling, which serve our CRSM high school students, and Alumni/Graduate Outreach which serves our CRSM graduates. These departments collaborate daily to provide support to the CRSM community.

### **School Counseling:**

This department consists of two school counselors: Christina Dippold and Deisy Del Rio. This department focuses on serving the students as a whole so they can achieve their best academically, socially and emotionally. Both counselors serve the students though individual meetings, group counseling, and presentations to student classes.

#### **College Counseling:**

This department includes two full-time college counselors: Martha Juarez and Beth Kainic. Together, they work to create a college-going culture at CRSM, with enrichment programs each year of high school. Focusing on grades 11 and 12, the college counselors facilitate classes on college access, college application completion workshops for seniors, and financial aid workshops for families.

#### **College Representative Visits:**

Visits from college representatives are welcome throughout the school year. We discourage visits on Tuesdays and Wednesdays because our juniors and seniors work at their CWSP jobs.
